Pictures of graduates were submitted by the colleges, families or students. Other graduates, without pictures, their degrees and colleges are also listed.



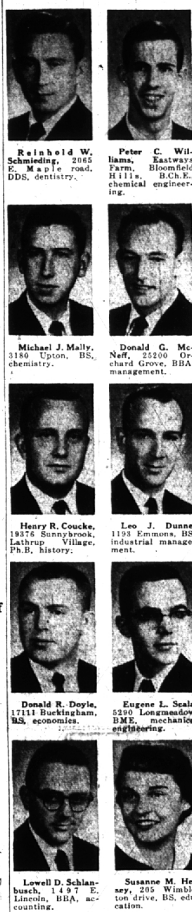
Exercises Honor U of M Graduates
