Still time to plant annual seeds such as Shirley poppy, gypsophila (baby's breath), bachelor buttons, gaillardias, scabiosa and zinnias.

Weeding of flower beds and borders can be ENDED now for the rest of the year by spreading BUCKWHEAT HILLS on the soil. Spread them 1 1/2 to 2" deep. Fifty pounds costs \$2.50 and covers 42 square feet to a depth of 1 1/2 inches.

A few unusual walnut and BEECH MEAT CARVING PLATTERS are still available. They ain't cheap—but real cool.

Plant dandelion seeds now for an early crop of spring greens. Don't sow them in the lawn.

Have you put on your summer application of fertilizer for the lawn? The lawn needs it. A well fertilized lawn requires less water. Use AGRICO URFAFORM, 10-6-4 (non-burning).

Use AGRINITE, 8 1/2-0-0 (completely organic). Use STADLER'S XXX, 10-6-4 (water in). Use WOODRUFF'S GRO-SOD, 10-6-4 (water in).

A new game is here—JARTS. It is for adults only and should be played BEFORE the cocktail hour.

Stop cutting asparagus and dress the bed with AGRICO 5-10-5 or STADLER'S 4-12-4 (4 lbs. to 100 sq. ft.).

Tomato plants may be thinned, supported or left alone. Supported plants bear earlier; unsupported plants bear longer. Put straw on the ground, and have longer toms—have tomatoes longer.

Prune Deutzias, spiraea, viburnums, and weigelas right after blooming. Same for Japanese Quince—but more lightly.

Birch leaf miners (and in fact most all bugs) can be controlled by spraying with BONIDE'S OUTDOOR AND GARDEN SPRAY.

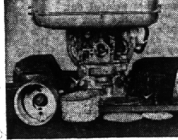


### Multi-Duty Fence

### Drain This Way

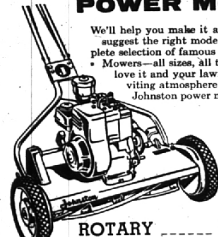

### Modern Fence Is Functional And Attractive

A modern fence is more than a barrier. It can be many things: A contribution to the living-out-at-home movement;

a contributor to the family's sense of privacy; and a convenient place for hanging outdoor equipment such as a garden hose, sprinkler, small tools and barbecue utensils.

The many-purpose fence can be both functional and decorative. A typical one can be made in an attractive style by using panels of peg-board and ridgeline, a linear-textured hardwood, on both sides of horizontal wood slats so that the design is good and the ventilation adequate.

The foot-wide 1/4" panels are spaced four inches apart on both sides of the fence on a ratio of two ridgeline to every peg-board strip in a criss-cross pattern that affords both privacy and a free movement of breeze.

Besides being a property divider and a place to hang outdoor equipment, a good-looking fence can add to the attractiveness of a property. It's an ideal project for the home handyman who likes to work out-of-doors in the summer while he improves the appearance and value of his real estate.

HOW DO YOU hang the tools and garden hose on a fence? With peg-board panels and fixtures, there's no problem, as there are dozens of metal fixtures available to fit any of the holes. A nice thing about this perforated hardwood, too, is that you can convert your fence in a jiffy to a prop for outdoor relaxation. Shelves may be hung from brackets for magazines or cooling drinks.

No wonder these fences have become so popular! They're easy to build, easy to look at and pleasant to have around.

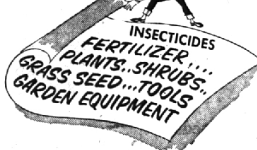
