

One use for the element cobalt is as a decolorizer in the making of pottery. Nearly all the clays used for this purpose contain iron which neutralizes the yellow and some form, which, on firing, gives rise to a yellow tinge. The addition of cobalt to the clay produces a complementary blue coloration which neutralizes the yellow and results in a pure white.

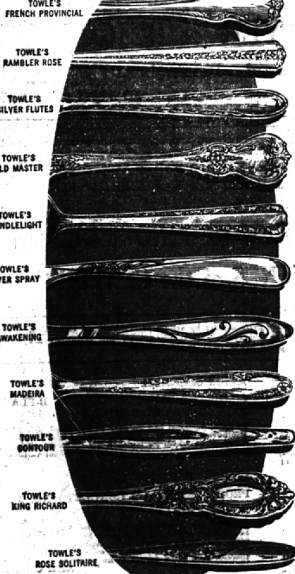
