4 State-Wide Groups Endorse School Bus Safety Bill

Passage Urged by State Police, Sheriffs, MEA, Supt. of Public Instruction

By GEORGE WM. AVERILL, Managing Editor. Four prominent Michigan leaders, speaking for themselves and their important state-wide organizations, this week urged the state house of representatives to approve a vehicle code amendment that would improve safety of school bus operation.

According to Farrell E. Roberts, legislator from Oakland's fourth district which includes the Birmingham-Bloomfield area... ROBERTS SAID the judiciary committee, of which he is a member, may report out a vote today...

"We definitely are for passage of the bill. Practically all other states have this two-way stop. It is only proper that Michigan also have it. I think this bill, as it now is drafted, is pretty reasonable. It would not work a hardship on anyone."
