## DOWN TO EARTH

### Exotic Plant Coaxed Into Bloom Here

Many winter travelers are tempted to bring home exotic plants which they see in various climates. Mrs. W. M. Scharh, 19940 Sunnyslope has been very fortunate in her experience with tropical plants.

In 1947 she brought a plumeria home from Hawaii and has been rewarded with very fragrant pink, waxy funnel-shaped flowers. In the summer, Mrs. Scharh places the plant outdoors. In the transplanting of the plant she has to be careful of the very brittle roots. The plant in winter is kept in a sunny south window. Oleander has also flourished for this plant lover. In a north window she keeps her canelia plant, which is in bud at this time. It has to be sprayed with water often.



When ever I hear about any one successfully growing a camellia I think of the professor who gave me my greenhouse training at Lansing. He used to say that many a retired plantman keeps himself in his old age by successfully growing camellias in the greenhouse for income, like an annuity.
