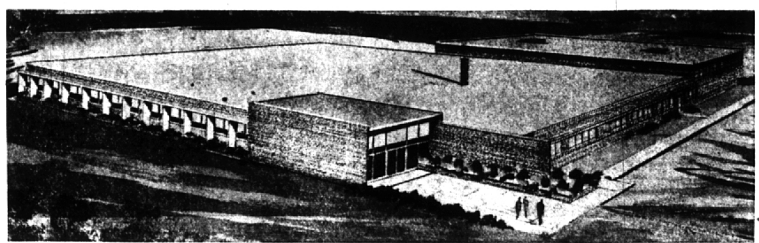

- Twins
- Brain Size
- Communal Therometers

Q. Medically, what is the difference between identical twins and ordinary twins?

A. First, let's start with a single fertilized egg. The fertilized egg begins to divide and rapidly forms a ball of cells from which the individual develops. If the cell ball splits, two individuals develop from the same egg. These are identical twins. They are of the same sex and are look-alikes. Twins of the other variety come from two fertilized eggs. These are called fraternal twins and have no greater resemblance than other brothers and sisters. Fraternal twins may or may not be of the same sex.

Q. A large brain and high intelligence go hand in hand. True or false?

A. Mainly false. A professor of zoology at the University of Copenhagen says that within limits, the weight of the brain does not seem to have a bearing on intelligence. However, mental deficiency does occur when the number of brain cells are below a certain limit. No one knows for sure what this limit is.

Q. Can disease germs be passed from one person to another by use of a single fever thermometer?

A. Yes. Some hospitals provide individual thermometers for each patient. In other cases a nurse may use five or six pills by personally attending the patient.

perature of thirty or so patients. Between patients the thermometers are kept in an antiseptic solution. In the home the medicine chest thermometer should be thoroughly cleaned after each use. A good way is to use soap and warm water and then wipe the thermometer with cotton saturated with alcohol. Rubbing alcohol will do.
