TROY — A 2,000 volume library has been offered to the city of Troy, but the city commissioners wonder if they can afford to accept it.

The offer came from the Big Beaver Methodist church. All the volumes have been catalogued by a church member, and the church has been operating its own library, open to all residents, for two years. But The Rev. Reginald S. Hocking suggested that the books might get more use if they were turned over to the city.

ALL THE commissioners thanked the church for its generosity. But because the growing city's budget is tight and the voters limited the tax ceiling to \$5 per thousand of assessed valuation, the commissioners doubt whether a library can be fitted into the budget.

Mayor Frank Costello emphasized that although the initial cost of operating the library would be small, it would have to be kept up. The commission finished at the \$100 rent asked by a former grocery building. Rev. Hocking suggested an suitable.

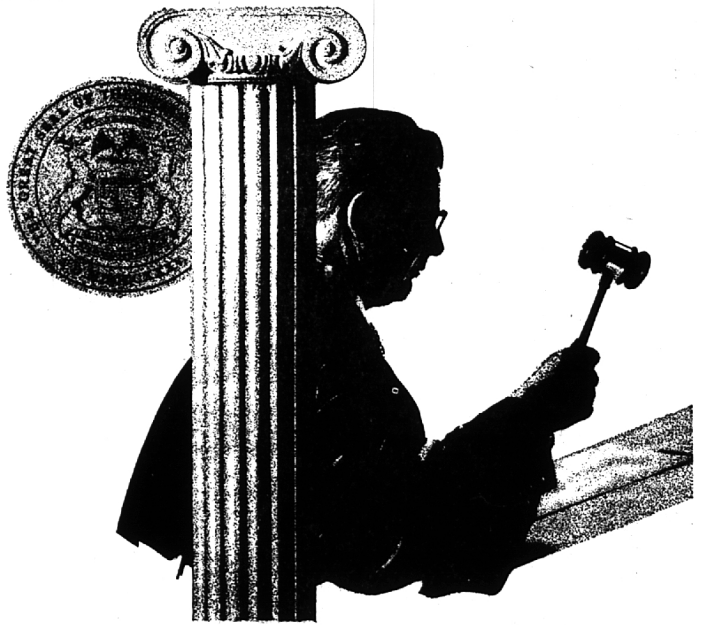
