 May 25 "Teen Town" will resume its bi-weekly meetings in the school auditorium.



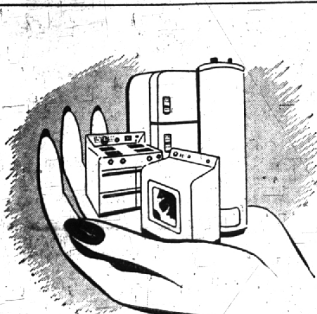
### Teens Go 'Girl Crazy'
