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Residents Meet With Chiera Rep On Rezoning Bid

While owners of property abutting what would be extension of Davis street consider its purchase, the Birmingham planning board has scheduled discussion on the property for its regular meeting, May 28.

Last week Wednesday the abutting property owners met in the Birmingham municipal building with E. D. Munde, who represents John Chiera. The request of Chiera on the vacant lots between Grant and Edgewood streets is rezoning from single family residence to multiple.

Munde earlier submitted drawings of preliminary plans Chiera was considering for an apartment house on the property.

Surrounding property owners have objected to the possible apartment construction. They suggested last week they would consider purchase of the property, and Munde advised them he would report back to Chiera for an opinion.
