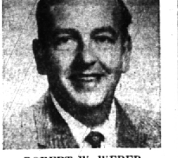

WHAT DOCTORS SAY ABOUT:

- Wryneck
- Nearsightedness
- Light For Reading

Q. What causes wryneck? Can it be cured?
A. Wryneck is often caused by shortening of a large muscle on one side of the neck. Some cases respond to massage and exercise—others require surgery. Early treatment prevents facial deformity that may result if the head is held in the tilted position for a number of years. Wryneck is sometimes due to eye disorders. The afflicted person keeps his head tilted in order to line up his vision. Correct the eye defect and the head usually straightens.

Q. Readers have asked the following questions about nearsightedness: Is it due to eyestrain? Is it something a child is born with? Will it get worse?
A. The average child is born with a fair amount of farsightedness. The eyeball is short or flattened. As the child grows so does the eyeball and in a few years vision is normal. In nearsightedness there is too much eyeball growth. The eyeball is longer than it should be and it is in this condition that causes nearsightedness.
