The City Commission of the City of Birmingham will meet, Monday, May 26, 1958, at 9:00 P.M. in the Commission Room of the Municipal Building to consider any objections to the construction of certain improvements described herein; and to the creation of a special assessment district to defray the cost of construction of an improvement to be hereafter known as:
COLE AVENUE WATER MAIN
consisting of the construction and installation of an 8 inch water main in Cole Avenue east of Elm Road, extending easterly approximately 160 ft. from the end of the existing 8 inch water main, which presently terminates at approximately the westerly line of Lot 273, Assessor's Plat 223-B.
The Commission proposes to create a special assessment district to defray the cost of this construction and said special assessment district shall consist of the following described property:

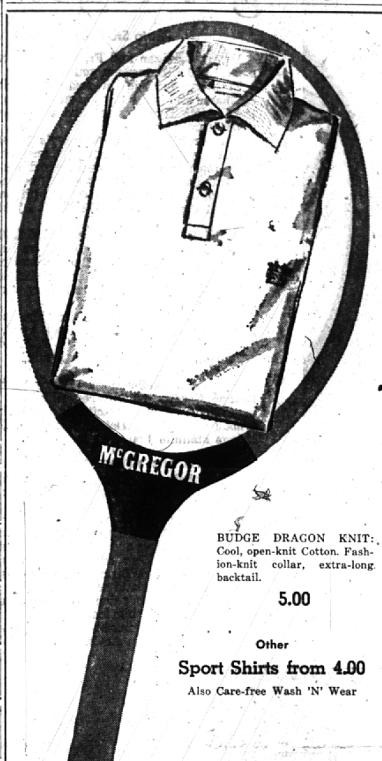

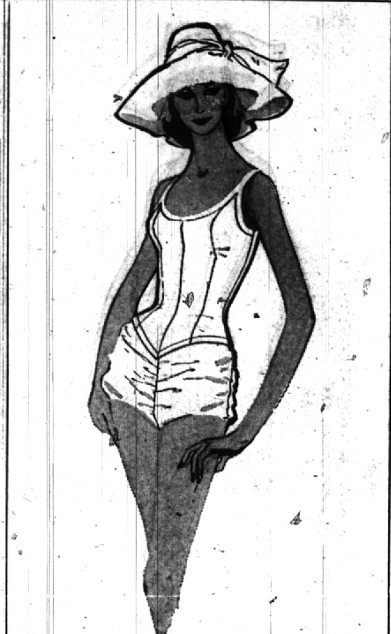
