**Do We Call It
"Chicago?"**

Indians called the area Cheka-gou meaning "place of skunk smells" because wild onions and skunk cabbage grew on the spot. In view of later stockyard odors, they were only mildly prophetic. First spelling "Cheka-gou" appeared in 1684 on a map published in Quebec. Oilhears recognized She-kag-ang as a natural crossroads, a great portage place. So of course, did shipping companies and railroads; and ever since people have been carrying their bags from one station to another in Chicago.

Indians were removed from area in 1833. Union Stockyards opened in 1865.
