Scout Troops Go On Hayride

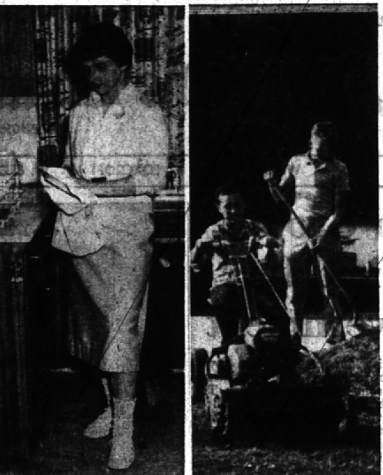
