

The Birmingham architectural firm of O'Dell, Hewlett and Luckenbach has been selected by the East Detroit school district to design and build the buildings for the district's new expansion program.

The program consists of providing 106 new classrooms consisting of additions to three existing buildings and four new elementary schools. The estimated cost of these combined projects, to be completed September, 1959, is about \$3,000,000.00.

Speaks at Business Planning Symposium


