## 'Good Design As a Way of Life' BAA Exhibit

One of the most interesting exhibits of the season opens Sunday at the Bloomfield Art Association galleries. Entitled, "Good Design as a Way of Life," the exhibit features the work of many nationally known designers who live and work in this area.

A highlight of the show is an exhibit of furniture featuring three 1958 award winners from the Association of Interior Decorators. Eero Saarinen, Florence Knoll and Hugh Astor. In the field of fabrics, the designs of Marianne Strengel and Gere Kavanagh are featured. Both are nationally noted for their work in this field.
