Electricians Repair Fire Damages

Electricians began working as soon as the area was cleared following the \$2,000 fire at the rear of Bodine's card shop, 172 N. Woodward early Saturday morning. Over 4,400 copies of the Detroit Free Press' Sunday supplement were burned. Birmingham Fire Chief Park Smith said an investigation to determine the cause was being continued

and firemen were out of the station only an hour. The fire shorted a nearby transformer and knocked out the traffic light at Hunter and Maple and affected electrical and phone service in other buildings in the area. Police first discovered the fire at 3:44 a.m. when it shorted the burglar alarm in the Detroit Bank and Trust Co.

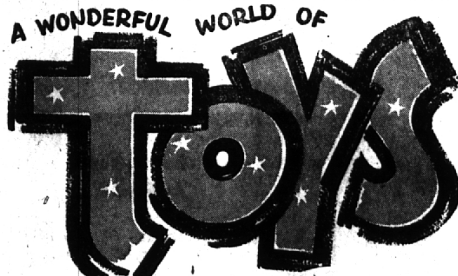
For That Stuffed Feeling, Try Weight Control

Have you got those "waistline blues" when it comes to Thanksgiving dinner? Does the sight of steaming turkey only remind you of the bathroom scales? Well, extension specialists in home economics at Michigan State University can't help you resist turkey and trimmings on Thanksgiving Day. But they can remind you of two handy leaflets that will help for the week after.

These are "Live Lean and Like It", (Extension Folder F-208), and "Counting Calories", (Extension Folder F-113). In "Live Lean and Like It" Dr. Margaret A. Olson reminds that controlling body weight is the most common headache that the healthy adult faces. The fact of "misery is company" is no help, however. She also reminds that, in our present society, adult underweights are rare—and extra pounds place a strain on the heart, arteries and knee joints.

THE REAL problem in weight

control, she says, is to decide how much extra fat has been stowed away. "Counting Calories" adds to this information with a calory list for most foods within the five basic nutrition groups. The leaflet also contains a chart showing daily caloric needs of various persons and includes low and high calory menus for the family. Both publications are available from the bulletin office, department of information services, Michigan State University, East Lansing.

A true die-in-the-wool TV viewer can watch everything from parades to sports during the day, beginning at 7 a.m. and lasting until nearly 11 p.m.—the late, late movie not-withstanding. MACEY'S parade will be seen on channel 4 at 11 a.m. following the Hudson parade with Bert Parks handling the commentary. For the sports fan, Texas University and Texas A & M will meet in their annual Turkey Day clash. This will come over WWJ-TV at 2:45 p.m.

The Toronto Maple Leafs host the Detroit Red Wings at 10 p.m. and the last period of that game will be shown over CKLW-TV.

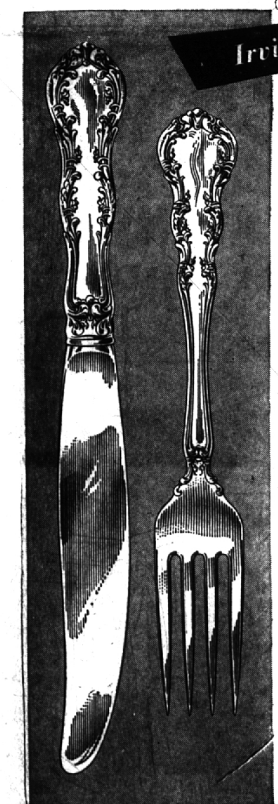
