

## Rev. Nicely Named Assistant Director Of Study Institute

CRANBROOK — The Rev. Paul L. Nicely has been appointed assistant director of the Institute of Advanced Pastoral Study at Cranbrook House, Bloomfield Hills. Announcement of Nicely's appointment came from the Institute's originator and director, the Rev. Dr. Ruel Howe.

The Institute of Advanced Pastoral Studies is a year-old program operated as post graduate training for ministers of all faiths. It is largely sponsored and financed by parishioners of Christ Church, Cranbrook.

Carols in word and song will have Mrs. W. W. Drake as commentator. Mrs. William Hohmeyer and Rodney Peterson will give organ and violin selections.

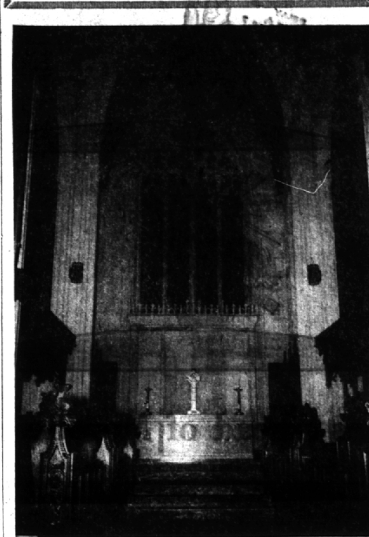
Mrs. Miles Welter, Mrs. A. E. Sanders and Mrs. Gerald Hause will sing several Christmas selections.

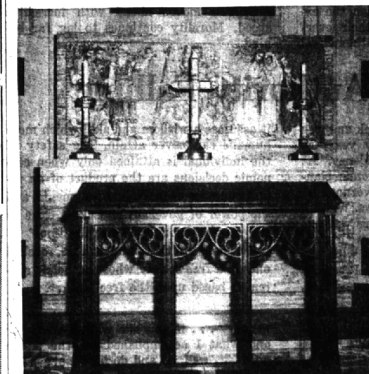
Election of next year's officers will follow Father Finnegan's talk.

## Kirk in the Hills Main Altar

These are the two major altars in the new Kirk in the Hills church, W. Long Lake Road, Bloomfield Hills. The church was dedicated Nov. 24. Dr. Harold C. DeVine, minister, gave the sermon, "How to Build Men," at the dedication ceremonies. The main altar with its sterling silver altar pieces is shown above, and below is the Melrose chapel altar. The multi-colored marble floor of the main altar and the Melrose chapel altar are from Carrara, Italy. The unique mosaic over the Melrose altar was also made in Carrara, by Montecatini, and took more than two and one-half years to complete. It captures the full significance of the scene at the foot of the cross the day Christ was crucified. The altar is made of Botticino and Roman Travertine marble.

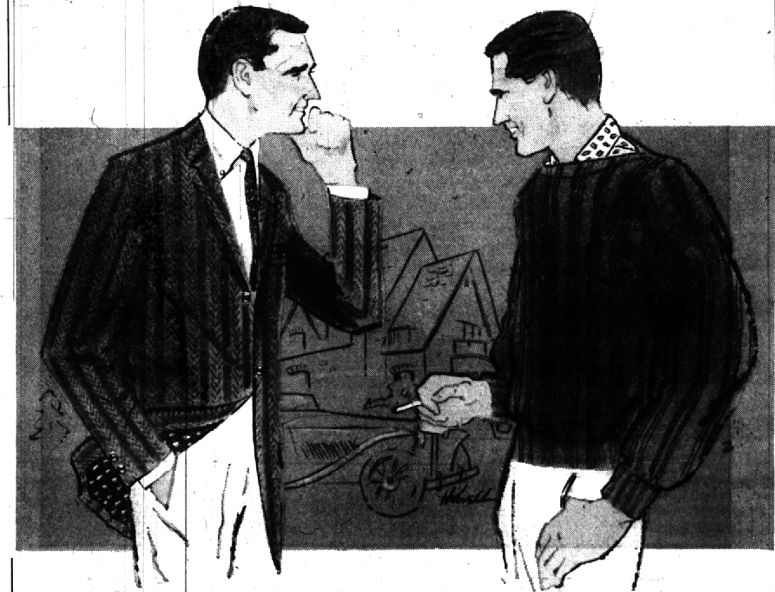

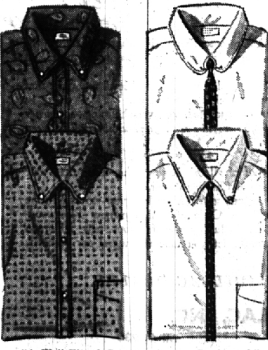
