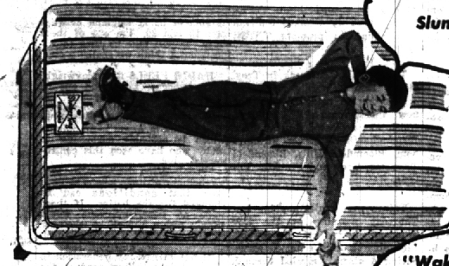
Proceeds for U.F.
