Local Man Named To Exclusive Club

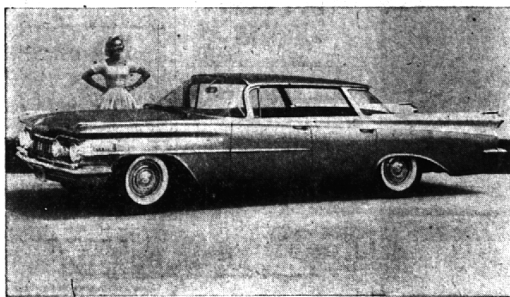

Committees Okay Proposed Merger

Four county committees recently approved the proposed merger of Oakland County's department of public works and drain commissioner's office.
