One of the biggest success stories of the year is that of Connie Francis, referred to in England as "America's singing sweetheart." She has recently made appearances on the Dick Clark Show, is currently raking in the funds in England, is planning TV spots with Perry Como and Pat Boone and is opening next month at the Copacabana. Her most recent smash, "Fallin'", is a terrific followup to "Stupid Cupid." "I'm Sorry I Made You Cry" and "Who's Sorry Now." Connie Francis is here to stay.

Paul Anka's version of "Just Young" is not as good as Andy Rose's, but may sell better because of Anka's reputation as a hit producer. The Four Coins, who have done well recently with "Wendy Wendy" and have that all-time hit with "Shangri-La," have a new one, "The World Outside," which is contending with the Four Aces, who were rolling off the hits a few years ago. The Coins should take the honors and the money with their disc.

The decline of the brand names in the record industry is reflected in Elvis' latest effort, "One Night," a rockaballed with a strong beat. The record will sell only because of Elvis, but you can mark this one down as his worst. Billboard announces that the Everly Brothers are slated for a new release next week.

For the first time no new releases have broken into the top ten. Many of the records hold the same place, but "Poor Boy" is showing signs of going down as fast as it came up. Also big in Baltimore, "It's Only Make Believe" by Conway Twitty took the big jump from eight to number three. "Fallin'" by Connie Francis, "Walkin' Along" by the Diamonds, "Call Me" by Johnny Mathis, "Just Young" by Andy Rose or Paul Anka, "With Your Love" by Jack Scott and "Lilly Lou" by Fabian are all very big and could hop the charts in the near future. Fabian is being plugged very much in the Motor City because of his personal appearances.

Southfield High Offers 2-Hour Seminar In Mathematics

SOUTHFIELD—If Johnny can add and do the other phases of mathematics, he may some day be enrolled in Southfield high's new two-hour math seminar, designed especially for the more advanced math scholar.

Taught by Kenneth Hull, who holds a BS degree in math from the University of Detroit, and a MA in math from the University of Michigan, the advanced group is composed of 15 students.

"We're trying to give the student, who has talent as much of a chance as possible, to learn advanced material," said Hull, "rather than keep him in a larger, shorter class, where he might become bored."

THE GROUP will handle solid geometry, analytical geometry, trigonometry, statistics and will

have an introduction to calculus before they graduate and go on to college.
 "The two-hour seminar, which is relatively new in Detroit-area schools, will enable us to discuss the more technical problems at length," said Hull. "Also, we find the students ask more questions in the smaller, less formal group, than they would in the average classroom," he added.
