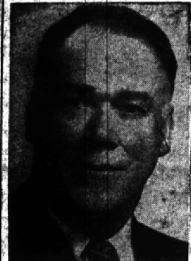

Students Ask --- Where Am I Going?

The question thousands of high school juniors and seniors are asking themselves is "Which college shall I go to?" And it's a pretty tough question to answer.

Though that is, unless a student writes away for lots of literature, or is able to visit several of the colleges he thinks he might like to attend, or is lucky enough to live in Oakland county where the American Association of University Women is sponsoring "College Advisory Night".

Next Thursday, Nov. 6 for the 18th time, the Oakland county chapter of AAUW is sponsoring "College Advisory Night" from 7:30 to 9:30 p.m. at Birmingham high school. Last year representatives from 70 colleges counseled with almost 1500 students.

QUALIFIED college representatives will try to answer students' questions about what colleges are best for certain fields of interest, which colleges have openings, annual tuition and living costs, admission requirements, college job

placement bureaus, high school preparatory courses, transfer of credits, housing facilities, choosing of roommates and opportunities for loans and employment.

Many of the colleges and universities represented have scholarships for which students from Oakland county will be eligible. Students can learn valuable information about these scholarships at next Thursday's advisory sessions. Juniors and seniors and their parents invited to attend the "College Advisory Night" session are from high schools in Berkeley, Birmingham, Bloomfield Hills, Clawson, Cranbrook School for Boys, Hazel Park, Kingswood School for Girls, Lincoln, Madison, Oak Park, Royal Oak, Dondero, Royal Oak Kimball, St. James, St. Mary's, Shrine of The Little Flower, Southfield and Troy.

New X-Way Route Indicated for Troy

The state highway department indicated last week that it is considering a new route for the Walter P. Chrysler expressway near the Troy area.

The state's new plan, according to Ashton J. Beert, Twelve-Town coordinator, leaves Stephenson near Twelve Mile and veers east. The route would enter Troy 2,000 feet east of Rochester road and stay east of Rochester until it passed Seventeen Mile.

It would then turn west on Lamb, cross Livernois somewhere near Hart and run northeast to the Chrysler Technical center property. The route there would run south of Nineteen Mile on Chrysler lane to Beach and then on north of Nineteen Mile to Adams.

Royal Oak officials tentatively agreed to the state plans last week.
