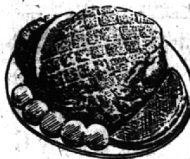

QUARTON students applauded him generously when the question and answer period concluded. Roper smiled at them and said, "I am pleased with you, too." Then he applauded them.

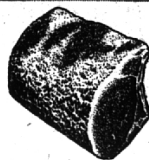
