AND IF THAT wasn't enough, they added a few twists of their own. Like playing the links in full "Halloween" regalia.

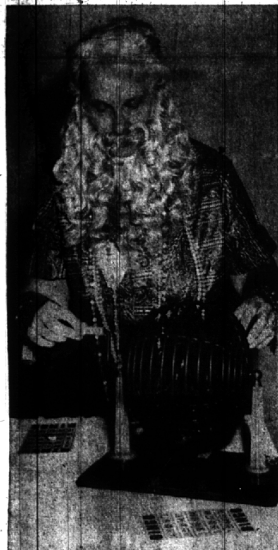
Such as the "circus", held Sept. 11 by the "does" of Birmingham country club, that The Birmingham women's editor, Fran Maier, visited for these golf photographs.

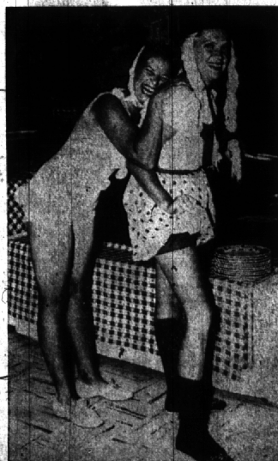
No circus is complete without a bearded lady, in this case Mrs. Claude Phelps, 184 Fairfax. She won second prize for the most authentic costume.

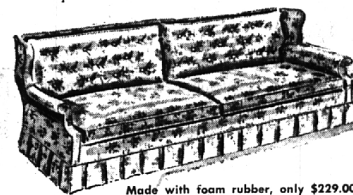
