Note: On July 1, 1943, the City of Birmingham became a participating member in the Southeastern Oklahoma County Sewage Disposal System, paying the sum of \$27,545.72 for certain privileges as a participating member. The system was a privately owned and operated sewerage treatment plant within the City of Birmingham and charges the City for the service.  
A sewage treatment plant was operated by the City of Birmingham until March 1, 1957. It was sold on that date to the North Evergreen Sewage Disposal Authority. The North Evergreen Sewage Disposal Authority is made up of four municipalities (including the City of Birmingham) and now operates the treatment plant, charging the participating member communities for service.

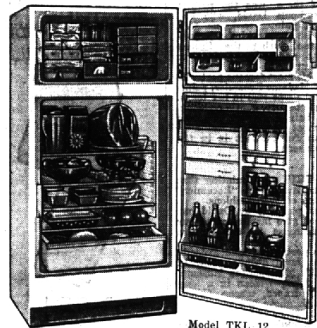
