## DOWN TO EARTH

# Garden Ideas Come from Denmark

DENMARK—The "Down to Earth" trip to Europe which will be sharing with you in the future began in Denmark. My hostess was Mrs. Alfred Gram from Birmingham, who is a staunch Danish woman and one of the few women in America who have been knighted by Frederick IX. Recognition came to her for her efforts in behalf of the children during and since World War II.

Since then she has received many decorations for her continued achievements in international child relief.

Frederick IX, the present king, is intensely interested in music and art. This interest of his is reflected in the parks and public gardens.

TV HAS only been in Denmark for four years. It is operated by the state without commercial entanglements. Each owner of a set pays approximately \$8.25 for his share of the cost of the entertainment.

I was told that only one per cent of the people are church goers. This is a striking fact if you report and I received the same answer the second time, so I guess I was hearing right.

When visiting the king and queen's summer palace at Fredensborg I saw a few illustrations of plant use to pass along. One of the most stunning flower beds had only purple heliotrope in the middle, bordered with purple ageratum. In another instance pink wax begonias were in a geometric bed bordered with purple ageratum.

There I saw a cross between a holly and a barberry which seemed to have taken the best characteristics of each parent. We will be seeing it on the market soon as well.

They gathered pine needles and placed them around their acid plants. In your garden the acid plants would be your rhododendrons and azaleas.

ONE OF THE most stunning plants for a rock garden was Viburnum Davidi, which I have just checked and found available in this country. It is 12 inches high, filled with clusters of white flowers followed by bright blue berries. The leaves have beautiful deep veins.

The handsome specimen of the day was a white horse chestnut, named Aesculus Parviflora. It was ten feet high and was a mass of white flowers in August. It would require full sun and takes on the profile of a shrub. Here is an answer for the person who wants a shrub which will be dramatic in August. It is very easy to "play the game" and have a prime performance of color with shrubs in May.

My notebook was brimming with ideas to study upon leaving this day.
