WHAT DOCTORS SAY ABOUT IT
• Poisonous Fish
• Eyebrows
• Underarm Odor
Q. I have read that certain fresh fish are poisonous. There are any way to tell which fish are poisonous?
A. No. Many tropical marine fishes that are used as food in one area may be violently toxic or poisonous in another. There is no simple test for determining whether a particular type of fish can be eaten.
Q. If the eyebrows are shaved will they grow back?
A. Yes, just as readily as any other type of hair. The average life of an eyebrow hair is about three weeks so it should take this long or longer for it to grow back.
Q. "What causes underarm odor?" I am at my wits end in trying to find a deodorant.
A. Underarm odor develops when sweat, which is normally odorless when first secreted, is chemically changed by skin germs. Keep the armpits germ-free and there would likely be no odor. It's hard to degerm the skin but it helps to use a soap containing hexachlorophene. Daily use of such soap gradually reduces skin germs. This plus a deodorant should be effective.
