### New Driver Misses Turn, Hits 8 Cars

A 58-year-old Detroit man is still wondering what happened when his car suddenly swerved into one car causing an eight-car chain reaction collision Sunday morning on Chester street.

Richard Gorbak told police he was in the middle of his fourth driving lesson Sunday when the car swerved while making a turn onto Chester street and struck a parked car.

HIS FOOT then slipped off the brake and onto the gas pedal and he struck a second parked car which in turn was pushed into a third car.

Gorbak bounced off the second car, struck another parked car, sideswiped a double-parked car discharging a passenger and then charged the street hitting another automobile.

The automobile salesman, Thomas V. Beagle, 47, who was giving Gorbak some practice time behind the wheel, suffered cuts on the forehead. Mrs. Gorbak, 57, had a bruised leg.

### Southfield Eyes 1-Mill Tax Hike In New Budget

**SOUTHFIELD**—A public hearing on Southfield's 1959-60 budget is slated for 8 p.m. Monday at the city hall. Under the new \$900,000 budget, residents would pay about \$4 per \$1000 of assessed valuation.

The new tax rate would be \$1 per thousand more than the five mill citizens paid in the new city's first year of operation. The charter limit is \$7.
