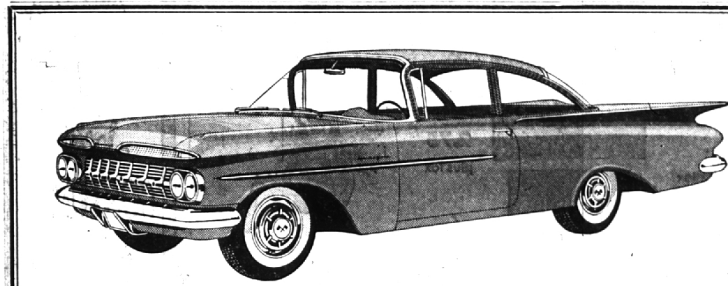

ORDINANCE NO. 25

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 1, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE AND RESTRICT THE LOCATION OF TRADES AND INDUSTRIES AND THE LOCATION OF BUILDINGS DESIGNED FOR SPECIFIED USES TO REGULATE AND LIMIT THE HEIGHT, ANCHOR BULK, OF BUILDINGS HEREAFTER ERRECTED, TO REGULATE AND DETERMINE THE AREA OF YARDS, COURTS, AND OTHER OPEN SPACES, TO LIMIT AND RESTRICT THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF FAMILIES WHICH MAY BE HOUSED IN DWELLINGS HEREAFTER ERRECTED OR ALTERED, AND FOR SAID PURPOSES DIVIDE THE VILLAGE OF BEVERLY HILLS INTO ZONES, TO PROVIDE A METHOD OF ADMINISTRATION, AND TO PRESCRIBE THE PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF ITS PROVISIONS."

The Village of Beverly Hills Ordinance No. 1, entitled "An Ordinance to regulate and restrict the location of trades and industries and the location of buildings designed for specified uses, to regulate and limit the height and bulk of buildings hereafter erected, to regulate and determine the area of yards, courts, and other open spaces, to limit and restrict the maximum number of families which may be housed in dwellings hereafter erected or altered, and for said purposes divide the Village of Beverly Hills into zones, to provide a method of administration, and to prescribe the penalties for the violation of its provisions," be and the same hereby is amended by amending the Zone Map attached thereto and made a part thereof as follows:

(a) Fences in Residential Zones shall not exceed 4 ft. in height above grade and shall not extend toward the front of the lot further than the rear of the house.
