They weren't too interested in seeing Cranbrook. "The type of architecture in Cranbrook is dead," one of them said.

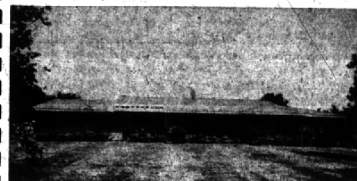

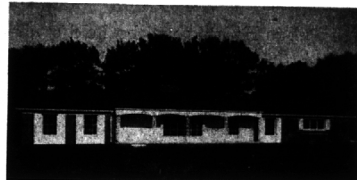

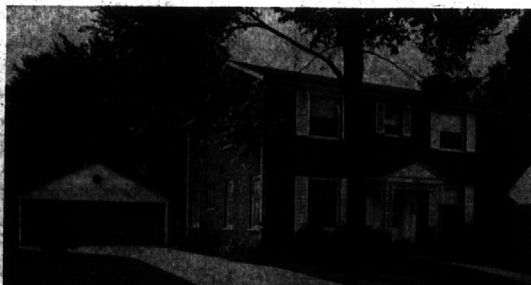
