## 'Go Rolling Along'—on Schedule

The Board of Education will operate school buses on the same basis as the past year, Assistant Superintendent of schools, Norman Wolfe, announced today.

Elementary students who live more than a mile from school and junior and senior high school students who live more than a mile and a half from school are eligible.

Within the corporate limits of Birmingham there will be Great Lakes Transit buses operating the same as last year on the same streets for those who are in need of transportation.

"WE HAVE found, Wolfe said, from past experience that to publish the 70 routes giving the streets that each bus will travel makes it almost impossible for the average parent to find the route that his child will be on.

"Therefore, for the last few years we have started our buses out on the same routes that they were traveling when school closed in June, then making adjustments necessary after the first couple of days of school.

For the parents new to the district, whose children will be transported he suggested that they contact a neighbor to find out where the bus stop is.

"THERE WILL be about 4,000 children transported next year, and for the parents to call the office becomes very confusing and I am sure that it would be much more simple for them to contact a neighbor," he said.

All Elementary routes, Seaholm high school routes and Derby Junior high school routes will remain the same.

The main change will be for students attending the Groves high school. All students west of Lahser road will have no change in routes, but all students in the 10th grade should ride on buses with 7th, 8th and 9th graders, formerly known as "Junior High" runs.

FOR THE AREA east of Lahser Road, transportation will be furnished along Lahser, starting at North Hampton, north to 14 Mile road and east on 14 Mile road to Eastlady.

All students living in the area bounded by the Rouge River on the West, Southfield on the East, 14 Mile road on the North and the school district boundary on the South will not be eligible for transportation.

The area between Southfield and Greenfield from 14 Mile road south to the school boundary is eligible for transportation. Three buses (number 29, 32, and 44) will handle this group.

THOSE LIVING east of Pierce will be picked up at 7:20 a.m. Those between Pierce and Southfield will be picked up at 7:45 a.m. At the close of the school day, (See SCHEDULE, Page 25)
