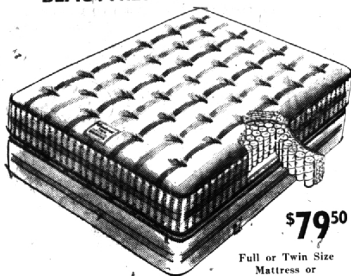

Perry is married, has two children and resides at 7122 Springridge road, Birmingham.

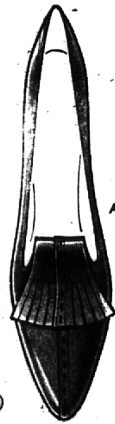
