BAA Announces Plans For Fall Art Instruction

Listing a wide scope of instruction for area art enthusiasts, the Bloomfield art association this week announced its fall session classes.

Studies in sculpture, composition, ceramic sculpture, life drawing, portrait painting and drawing, watercolor painting, oil painting, colors, oils, interior design, creative dance and a young people's workshop will swing into progress beginning Sept. 14.

Both the interior design and creative dance programs are new headliners this year. Most of the classes are scheduled as four-week sessions. Enrollment fee is \$25 (less 20 per cent for art association members).

SCULPTURE COMPOSITION and ceramic sculpture will be taught by Vera Kline. Her three classes will be Monday mornings from 9:30 to noon; Monday afternoons from 1:30 to 4:30; and Monday evenings from 7 to 9:30.

Her instruction program begins Sept. 14 and will be directed toward giving the student knowledge of various sculptural media: clay, plaster, wood and stone. The class is open to men and women, beginning and advanced students.

CLIFFORD B. WEST will instruct a life drawing class Monday evenings from 7 to 9:30. Beginning Sept. 14, the class will be open to both men and women, beginning and advanced. A second class is slated from 9:30 to noon on Thursdays.

West allows students to sketch in any medium from the model and encourages individual interpretations. The class fee is \$30.

PORTRAIT PAINTING and drawing classes for men and women is planned Tuesday mornings from 9:30 to noon. Instructor Mildred Williams will start classes Sept. 15 for beginning and advanced students.

Artists will draw and paint from the costumed model. No specific style or manner will be stressed. A STUDIO ART class for business men only will be under the direction of Albert Muller on Tuesday evenings from 7 to 9:30. With stress on the part time artist, individual instruction will be given in both the materials and form of the development of concept and skill.

MARY JANE BIGLER and Dorothy Stoddard will teach Wednesday classes in watercolor painting. Mary Jane Bigler will teach advanced students on Wednesday afternoons from 1 to 3:30, beginning Sept. 16.

Wednesday evenings from 7 to 9:30, Mrs. Stoddard will teach to beginning students. She will highlight an introduction of materials with emphasis on composition and development of individual technique.

Kathleen Birch will direct painting classes Thursday mornings from 9:30 to noon and from 1:30 to 3:30 p.m. Beginning Sept. 17, the instruction will be mostly in still life, flower studies with individual instruction directed toward the development of individuality.

TWO NEWCOMERS to the Art Association educational staff are Walter Ludwig and Claire Levine. Miss Levine will teach creative "dance to teenage girls and adult women who seek expression in the medium of movement.

Classes will be held at the Birmingham WMAA, 400 E. Lincoln. Adult classes begin at 10 a.m. Sept. 16 and last ten weeks. Teenage classes will be held at 4 p.m., beginning Sept. 17.

LUDWIG will instruct interior design and decoration classes Thursday evenings from 7 to 9, beginning Sept. 17. The class is planned for persons in trades, professions and crafts allied with interior design. The class fee is \$15. Lectures will be supplemented by illustrations and field trips.

IN CONJUNCTION with Detroit Institute of Arts Extension Services, the BAA will again schedule **Roeper Starts Five-Week Study Tour**

George Roeper, director of City and Country school for gifted children, Bloomfield Hills, left Saturday for a five-week educational field study of Japan, Korea, Hongkong, and Manila.

Roeper will join twenty teachers and professors from U. S. schools as part of the delegation of the comparative education society. Roeper's last field study as a delegate was to Russia where he studied the Russian educational system.

The purpose of the delegation is to study the public and private educational systems, which include pre-school, elementary and high schools and colleges, and in addition, the training of teachers in the respective countries.

The educators will talk with educational authorities and teachers, and visit classrooms where they will have an opportunity to speak with the pupils.

Roeper will specifically study to what degree the system provides for the education of the gifted children.

A CHILDREN'S bill of rights, drawn up by the elementary children at City and Country school, will be presented to the children of those other countries.

Roeper hopes to secure a comparison between what American children consider as their rights as children, and what other children consider in their own rights.

Through this document, Roeper will be able to study the educational and moral concepts as affected by their life at home and at school.
