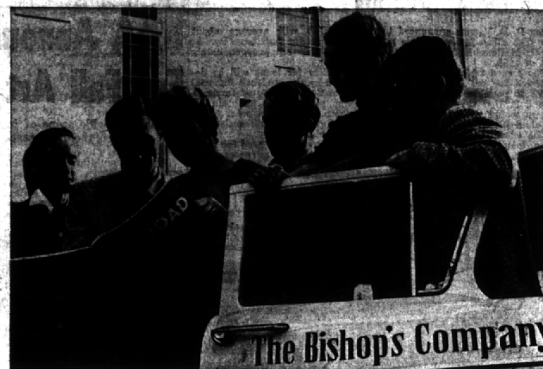

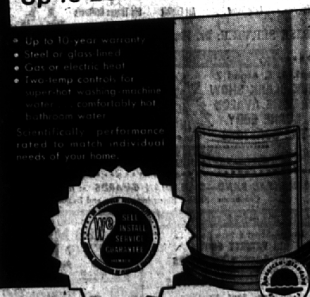
## Presbyterians Plan Aug. 30 Reception For Rev. Gibson
