You went away on your vacation and when you got back the garden was full of weeds and the lawn looked like Sam Scratch. You had your fingers crossed when you left hoping that we'd have enough rain to keep things green, but now you know we didn't. Crabgrass has taken over all or part of the lawn and purslane (pig weed) is bigger than the Portulaca (which it resembles).

So now what do we do? The magic wand of September will soon be along to help but it can't do it alone—So get busy.

The Purslane is easy—pull it now before each a little yellow blossom scatters several hundred new seeds to plague next year.

The crabgrass offers you several options:

1. If it is still green you can kill it with K.O. Ortho, or Crab Not.

2. If it is already turning brownish purple rake the ends up before mowing, then mow and catch the clippings in the bag of a new TORO WHILL-WIND Mower. You can also sweep them up with a PARKER SPRINGFIELD which you will then have around to gather up your leaves this fall.

The seed you sow now will germinate and become tough enough to stand the winter in good shape. You'll want to fertilize first with Agrico 10-6-4. Agrico Area Form or XXX at 20. lbs. per 1000 sq. feet or Regal at 40 lbs. per 1000.
