MEXICO CITY—Two Birmingham residents, Ray Shull (left), son of Mr. and Mrs. Charles L. Shull, 6920 E. Dartmoor, and Peter Whims, (right), son of Mr. and Mrs. Howard Whims, 5835 Putnam, are studying south of the border at Mexico City college, the only American-type liberal arts college in Latin America. According to statistics released by the Institute of International Education, the college has a larger enrollment of American students outside the United States than any other university abroad, including the Sorbonne in Paris. At MCC all classes are taught in English, except for a few in the graduate school. The credit system is the same as in U.S. colleges and universities. Courses of study, taught by a distinguished international faculty educated in Europe, Latin America and the United States, lead to the B.A. and M.A. degrees. Average enrollment is more or less 1,000 students a quarter. Both Shull and Whims are graduates of Birmingham high school. Whims is studying creative writing and Shull is in engineering.

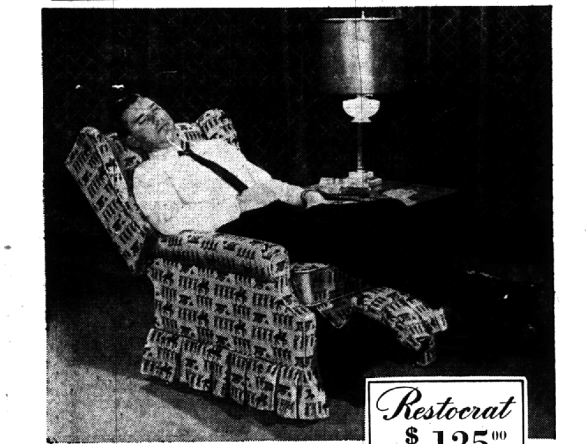

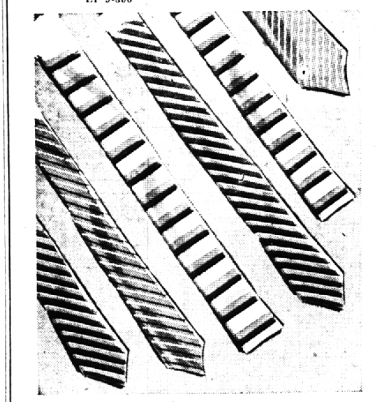

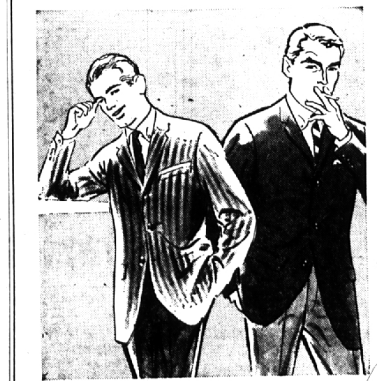
