**Engagement Announced**

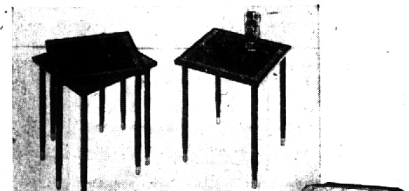

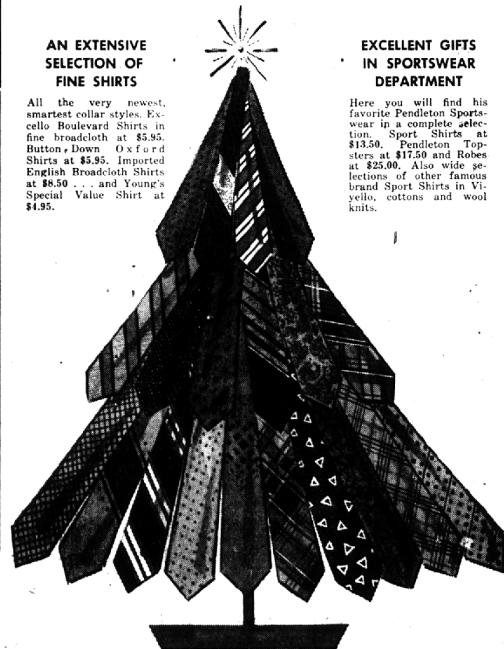
