"THEY ALL PAID a heavy price to make this one of the turning points in world history. Capt. Sturges' Michigan cavalry routed the cavalry of Jeb Stuart just west of Gettysburg. No state in the Union played a more important role than did the then small (population-wise) state of Michigan."
In addition, Michigan's most distinguished Civil War hero, Maj. Gen. Alpheus S. Williams, commanded the Federal 12th Corp during the Gettysburg campaign. His biography, "From the Cannon's Mouth," has just been published. His great-great-granddaughter, Mrs. Edward A. Proctor Jr., lives in Birmingham.
