Airman Kroll, a graduate of Birmingham high school, is in a specialized training course in jet and missile mechanics. He has been in the Air Force since October.

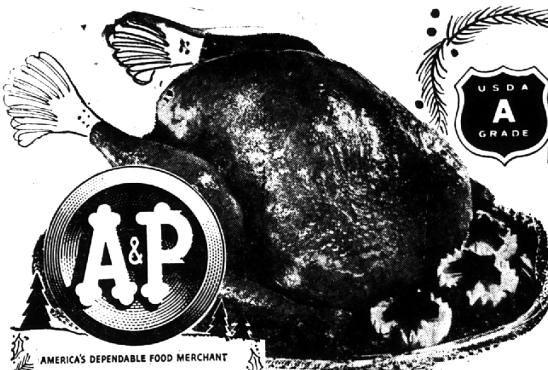
Floyd M. Barba, Jr., Beverly Hills, public safety department sergeant, will return the Southfield city police department in January.
