**Citizens Themselves Meet for First Time**

Oakland County chairman Murray D. Van Wagoner today called the first general membership meeting of Citizens for Michigan for 8 p.m., Dec. 14 at the Central High School auditorium, Pontiac, Michigan.

The county-wide rally was called following a meeting of the Oakland county Citizens for Michigan initiating a committee at the Birmingham community house, Birmingham, Monday evening, Nov. 27, attended by five officials of the state organization and by representatives from 18 communities throughout Oakland county.

THE PURPOSE of the Dec. 13 meeting will be to encourage the formation of local chapters throughout Oakland county to study major state problems, and to formulate recommendations for their solution. In explaining the objectives of Citizens for Michigan, state chairman George Romney said such a concept, if broadly applied, provides an opportunity to counter the recent charge by Premier Khrushchev that the United States, like the Soviet Union itself, is ruled by powerful minorities.

The way to overcome such criticism is to get more people interested in government, Romney said. Citizens for Michigan offers the people a mechanism for self-education in government affairs which will make it possible for an informed and aroused electorate to express its will effectively, thus freeing the two major parties from domination by powerful economic organizations, he stated.

OTHER SPEAKERS included Mrs. Berrien Ketchum and William Frank, members of the state executive committee, C. Allan Harlan, finance committee chairman and Martin Bittel, board member. Romney, Mrs. Ketchum, and Frank are scheduled to speak at the Dec. 14 meeting. Former governor Van Wagoner appointed Melvin F. Lanphar, of Detroit, chairman of the state committee for the coming meeting. He will be assisted by Mrs. Detwila Lessler, Lake Orion and Mrs. George Dillman, Rochester. An information committee also was appointed consisting of Wil-
