

## In Oakland County... Completion Date Seen Jan. 1 for N. Evergreen

PONTIAC—By Jan. 1 work will be completed on all of the Evergreen interceptor sewer north of 14 Mile road, former DPW Director Harold K. Schone said this week.

Septic tanks must be abandoned and homes connected to the big new sewer within six months after it is available, according to county health ordinance.

Final completion date for the \$6,119,000 Oakland county department of public works project is set for June, Schone said. Work began last June.

ALREADY many Birmingham area subdivisions have petitioned for and started the building of lateral sewers to connect to the Evergreen.

The ruling on home owners connecting with the sewer says it must be done within six months after the sewer becomes "available."

Though the word "available" has not been clearly defined by county attorneys, Schone said this week that "a reasonable available distance from a home might be a half-mile."

UNTIL THE final arm of the Evergreen is connected to Detroit's system at Eight Mile road next June, the Birmingham disposal plant will temporarily treat the sewage. Many small existing sewer systems will be connected immediately.

In many municipalities, the sewer will be paid for by a connecting charge of \$250 to \$300. Home owners must also pay their share of the lateral sewer leading to the main arm, and the cost of a "lead-in line" from the street to individual homes.

**Circuit Judges Catching Up On Court Docket**

Once lagging far behind on county civil and criminal cases, the Oakland circuit court is in the best condition in years, a court official said this week.

The docket is in better shape than any time I can remember," said Assignment Clerk Louis E. Fairbairn.

A year ago the court was estimated to be nine months behind on civil cases and lagging even further on criminal cases.

Today the docket carries comparatively few of both types of cases.

The county board of supervisors has before it a proposal to cut circuit judges' pay \$1,000. Said one official, "The judges themselves have been pushing these cases through and urging lawyers and the prosecutors' office to do the same."
