**MSU-O Workshop Teaches Teachers**

A Workshop for Church school teachers will be held at Michigan State University Oakland on Saturday, Dec. 5, to acquaint church and Sunday school teachers of all faiths with new effective techniques in instructional methods. The program is part of the series of adult educational efforts co-sponsored by the recently organized Clergy Friends of MSU-O which held a Clergyman's convocation at the university last Oct. 7.

All churches of the Oakland-Macomb area have been invited to enroll members of their church-school staffs for this program which will commence with registration at 8:30 a.m. and terminate in the afternoon at 3:30.

The program will center around the presentations of a secular educational expert and that of an experienced religious educator.

THE REV. Douglas Parker of St. Paul's Methodist church, Rochester, and chairman of the planning committee for the workshop stated that although the program is specifically geared for the church school teachers it should be of equal interest to ministers and directors of religious education.

Churches have been urged to communicate with the Director of Continuing Education, MSU-O, for details and to reserve space in the program.
