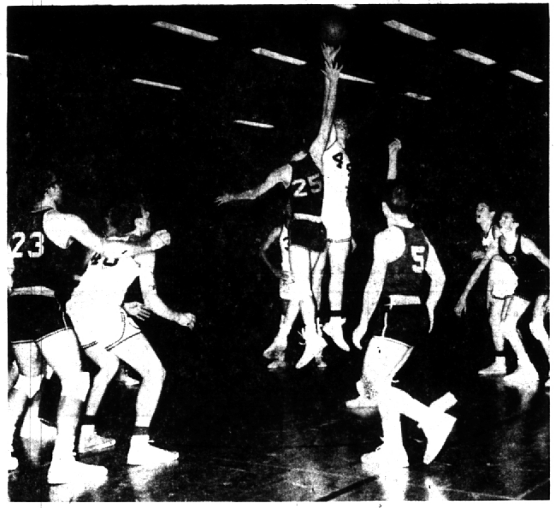



A bundle of silver amounting to \$600 was found on a lonely Frank-


