Issue of September 3
Bids on the Birmingham Library addition were \$40,000 above the estimated cost and Sgt. Malcolm "Security" Ross retired from the Birmingham police department to take a full time job with the local board of education at Seaholm high school.

Bloomfield Plaza in Bloomfield township opened four stores of the new shopping center at Telegraph and Maple.

Three Beverly Hills officials resigned their posts. Councilman Robert B. Reed and plan board members Herbert Herzberg and Clifford N. Wright left the positions because of business interests.

Area prep football starts began two-day workouts a week before school opening.

Issue of September 10
An 18-year-old Birmingham girl was arrested for robbing a cab driver at knife-point and a 17-year-old from W. Bloomfield township youth, arrested on suspicion of attempted theft, hung himself in the Birmingham jail with his nylon shirt.

Former Birmingham Eccentric society editor Eleanor Vinnall was appointed assistant editor of the Tool Engineer.

Franklin was scheduled to get a new post office building and the contracts were signed to start construction.

Issue of September 21
An editorial in The Birmingham Eccentric seemed to calm down members of the board of education and residents and students who were objecting to the name change at the high school.

The editorial put the name change in its proper light and remarked that there had been too much fuss over the proposal.

Some students, irked over the change, had painted "Forever Birmingham" in big red letters on the front of the school.

SERVICEMEN AND VETERANS
HOMESTEAD TAX EXEMPTION

IF YOU ARE:

1. A veteran of the Spanish American War.
2. A veteran of World War No. 1 and have a service or non service connected disability recognized by the United States Veterans Administration upon which compensation is paid.
3. An active service man.
4. A veteran of World War No. II who has a service or non service connected disability recognized by the United States Veterans Administration upon which compensation is paid.
5. Unmarried widow of any of the above.
6. Resident of the State at least 6 months prior to service.
7. Resident of the State at least 5 years prior to filing affidavit.

THEN YOU ARE entitled to homestead tax exemption on \$2,000 of assessed value, PROVIDING: on January 1, 1960, you owned and occupied the property as a homestead, did not own property assessed at more than \$7,500, make application between Jan. 1st and February 15, 1960.

Application may be made at the office of the City Assessor, Municipal Building, who will assist you.

Bring deed or land contract, discharge papers, RECENT proof of receiving compensation for service or non service connected disability, if you are receiving same.

We respectfully suggest that application be made as soon after January 1st as possible.
