

1937 Proposed and processed administrative changes from old justice to new Municipal Court for Pontiac. New court showed low cost of operation and efficient case disposition.

1941 Refired as Pontiac Judge — replaced by two appointees.

1943 Entered military service as enlisted man.

1946 Chief legal administrator of military establishment when released from service.

1954 Established home, and young son, in lage of Clarkston. 1955 Employed as Clarkston VII-lage attorney and still acting. acting.

1957 Retained as Independence
Township attorney and still
acting.
