'Mark an X' System May be Franklin's Election Procedure

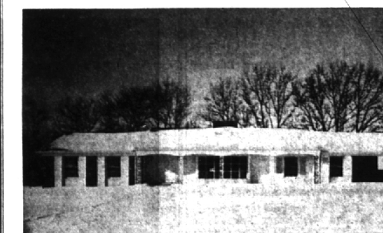

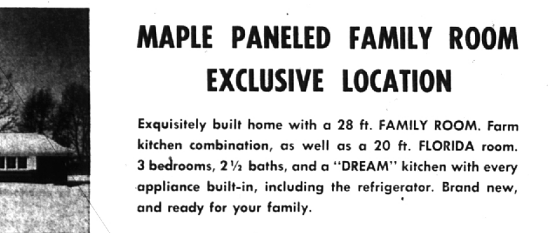
