Susan Lowe Ready For Cooking School

Hundreds of Women Expected Next Week At Two-Day Event

Women of the Birmingham-Bloomfield area will be guests of The Birmingham Eccentric Tuesday night and Wednesday afternoon.

At this time, homemakers will have an opportunity to learn new and exciting surprises in cookery at the Cooking School sponsored by The Eccentric. The school will be conducted by the noted food lecturer, Susan Lowe, who will bring a tempting array of new recipes and household hints.

HIGHLIGHTS of the Cooking School will include demonstrations of newest cooking methods, new menu ideas, new ways to plan, prepare and serve meals. Homemakers will be flocking to the Birmingham Community House at 8 p.m. Tuesday and 2 p.m. Wednesday for a full two hours of cooking, food freezing and fun. You'll learn how to make new and interesting desserts and main course dishes as well. Susan Lowe will use a special mirror and lighting device during her program enabling everyone in the audience to see exactly what she is doing.

THE DEMONSTRATION will include recipes for everyday meals—made quickly and easily—as well as desserts and new tricks for homemakers. Susan Lowe's favorite recipes will be given to the women attending along with dozens of free prizes and grocery bags.

Taste-tempting recipes which will be included in the two-day school are such goodies as Hawaiian Tibbits, Garden Party, Salad with sour cream dressing, Creamette Picture Pot, Batter-scrunch Oatmeal Crisps, Empress Salad, Fresh Fruit Dressing, Fluff Fudge, Corn Flake Meringues, Ham and Maple Bananas, Vegetable Bowl, Baked Ham with a tangy glaze, Outdoor Pancakes, Pizza-Burgers and Spoon Bread.

Helpful Hints

FOR HELPFUL hints besides her interesting lectures, Susan says—plan your kitchen work ahead, so you have more precious time to spend with your family. —right after using, fill cooking pans with hot water, except those pans in which cereal, egg and milk dishes have been cooked, then use cold water. —do your messy tasks, such as paring potatoes or cleaning vegetables, on paper towels which can be easily picked up and disposed of quickly. —keep all cleaning supplies in small basket and carry from room to room while cleaning. Saves steps

and energy!
 —think pleasant, happy thoughts, and do your party planning while you're doing those household chores; it will make your tasks easier!
 —make one night each week a "party" night for your family by surprising them with a new and different main dish or dessert; make use of those recipes you have been clipping and meaning to use, or "browse" through your favorite cookbook.
 —plan your meals to give double happiness—a good food, for health and vitality—and attractive food, served with that added touch that makes it good to look at, as well as good to eat.

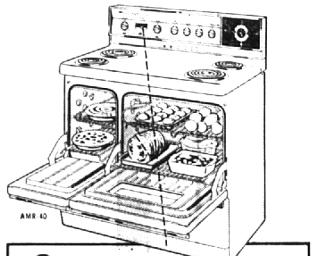
