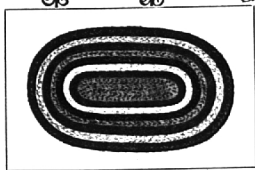

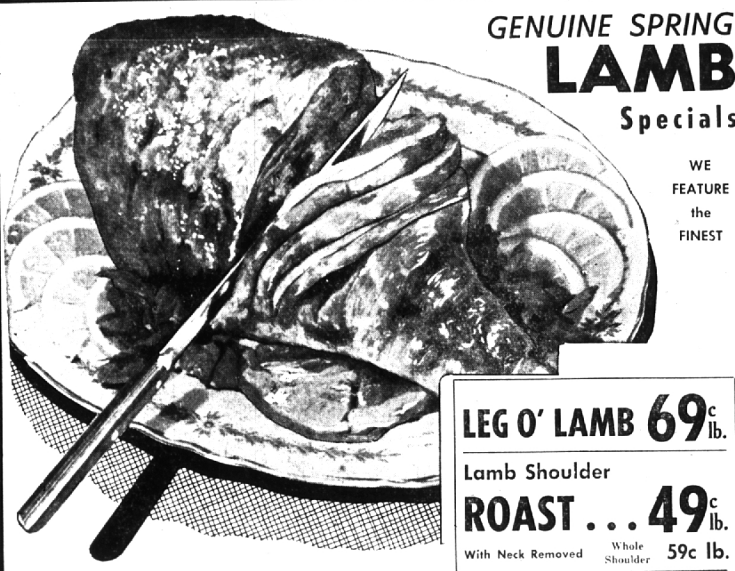
Simeon attended the Birmingham schools and was a member of the First Methodist church.
