

Urge Use of Short Income Tax Form

The Internal Revenue Service announced that the short form income tax return, 1040-A, can be used by many more taxpayers when filing their Federal income tax returns.

This year, taxpayers can use the Form 1040-A in their cases, subject to withholding, are less than \$10,000. Up to \$200.00 can be shown on the 1040-A if it was from interest, dividends, or wages

not subject to withholding. However, if any combination of income adds up to \$10,000 or more, taxpayers cannot use Form 1040-A.

R. I. Nixon, district director of Internal Revenue Service, urged that all taxpayers investigate the Form 1040-A requirements. He said use of the Form 1040-A will save much time and effort by those eligible to use it.

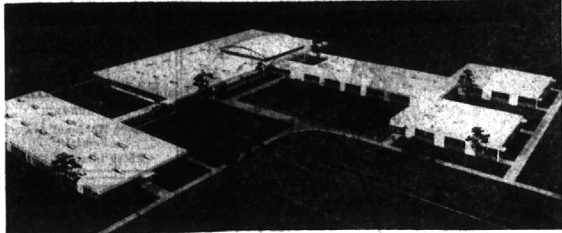

School Building Costs Cut In New Utica Junior High

School construction has been a controversial topic in the Birmingham area since last summer when the school board announced plans for the new junior-senior high school.

And it will cause discussion in Utica now that the school system there has come out with a plan to reduce building costs by 25 per cent or more.

THE PROPOSED cut will be instituted in a \$1 million junior high school on 19 Mile road in Utica. It will accommodate a 900 maximum enrollment.

The new junior-senior high school in Birmingham will cost \$2,260,000 and will take care of a maximum 2,000 students.

Bloomfield Hills school district voters recently voiced a protest against school costs when they turned down a bid for a \$1,665,000 bond issue for construction of new schools and increased tax millage.

ACCORDING TO Fred M. Atkinson, superintendent of Utica Community schools, the concept calls for maximum use of standard or stock size building materials which provide quality at a lower cost.

This approach toward low-cost architecture is being advanced by Smith-Smith Architects of Royal Oak and Iron Mountain. Edward W. Gabhart, 1813 Derby, is the project architect.

THE SCHOOL board originally planned to construct 69,000 sq. ft. of school space for the funds available. However, through this new plan, the space figures jumped to 150,000 sq. ft.

The additional space includes a 9,000 square-foot wing, which will accommodate 180 extra students at a cost of \$10 per square foot.

TOTAL COST of the building is \$917,000—an average of 82 cents per cubic foot and \$11.50 per square foot which compares with \$15 per square foot for routine construction and with \$17 to \$20 per square foot for many new schools in the nation.

Classes will begin next fall, 10 months after the start of construction.

THE ONE-STORY school will be constructed partly of 8 by 10 foot precast concrete panels with the remainder of the exterior finished in face brick.

Light weight concrete will be used for roofing and formica-covered doors, terrazzo and resilient tile is specified for the flooring.

Low transmission glass will be used to eliminate need for shades or curtains.

AND ARCHITECTS have planned to use a high-temperature

heating system to reduce size and cost of heating pipe-work.

Mechanical and electrical consulting engineers are B. A. King and Associates, 884 South Adams.

INCLUDED IN the building are 20 dual-purpose classrooms, a gymnasium that divides into two Sections, a library, two locker rooms, two homemaking laboratories, a wood shop, a metal shop, two music rooms, two arts and crafts rooms, administration quarters and the usual utility rooms and lavatories.

All corridors are on the outside walls of the building, providing sun shade and eliminating the need for a cantilever or overhang.

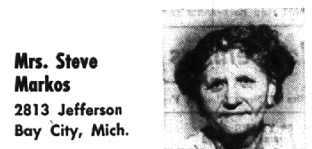
