

ment and installations shall conform to the provisions of the Electrical Code of the City of Birmingham.

700.14 Heating.—All heating equipment shall conform with established fire prevention standards. Salamanders, braziers, portable heaters or other open fires shall be prohibited.

700.15 Power Working Machines.—Power woodworking machines and saws shall be located in separate masonry walled buildings with concrete floors.

700.16 Sawdust.—Sawdust, shavings, sawdust and refuse materials shall be permitted only under boilers, in furnaces, or in incinerators or refuse burners constructed and located according to the provisions of the Birmingham Building Code.

700.17 No Smoking.—No smoking shall be permitted except in specific locations in buildings. Large "NO SMOKING" signs shall be posted on building exterior walls and on board signs, erected at all entrances to such buildings.

700.18 Weeds in Yard.—Weeds shall be kept down throughout entire yard and shall be sprayed as often as needed with a suitable herbicide.

700.19 General Maintenance.—Debris, sawdust, chips, shorts, etc., shall be removed regularly from piling areas and not less frequently than once a week.

700.20 Repair & Parking of Vehicles.—Vehicles shall be garaged in a separate masonry walled, or equivalent construction, building with concrete floors.

700.21 Dry Kilns.—Dry kilns shall be of fire-resistive construction and shall be detached. Dry kilns shall be provided with an approved installation of steam traps, or other approved means of smothering fire.

700.22 Locomotive and Trolley Buildings.—Dry kilns shall be provided in separate buildings or in the open with adequate clear space between yard buildings or open yard storage.

700.23 Spark Arresters.—Spark arresters shall be provided for chimneys or stacks of all buildings burning solid fuel within 100 feet of open piling areas and building buildings.

700.24 Fire Detectors.—Fire alarms.—When a fire starts, no matter how small, the municipal fire department shall be called.

700.25 Automatic Fire Alarm System.—Means of automatic transmission of fire alarm signals to the fire department shall be provided for all totally enclosed buildings exceeding 6000 (six thousand) square feet in floor area.

700.26 Fire Extinguishing Equipment.—First aid fire extinguishing equipment shall be provided for all open yards and in all buildings. Class (A) approved type fire extinguishers shall be provided.

700.27 Automatic Sprinklers.—The installation of automatic sprinklers is required in all fully enclosed lumber storage buildings, wood stacks or incinerators.

700.28 Watchman Service.—Watch service shall be maintained nights, Sundays, and holidays and whenever premises are not open for business in all establishments having an aggregate floor area of all buildings exceeding 2000 (two thousand) square feet.

CHAPTER B CARBIDES

800.01 Licenses.—No public garage shall be operated in the City of Birmingham without a license having been obtained therefrom from the City Clerk.

800.02 Method of Piling.—No flammable liquid with a flash point below 100 degrees F. shall be used in any building for washing, cleaning or removing grease or dirt, unless in a special closed machine approved by the fire department.

800.03 Handling Flammable Liquids.—All gasoline exclusively if used in the tanks of vehicles shall be stored in underground tanks, protected by concrete.

800.04 Miscellaneous.—No smoking in any public garage where flammable liquids or vapors are present and suitable "NO SMOKING" signs shall be displayed.

800.05 Fire Extinguishers.—All public garages shall be kept clean and there shall be no accumulation of rubbish or dirt permitted. Self-closing metal doors shall be used for all entry ways or ramps or waste exits.

800.06 Spray Painting.—Spray painting shall conform to the requirements as outlined in this ordinance, Chapter IV.

800.07 Tire Rebuilding.—Tire rebuilding shall be conducted in a separate building or in a separate room, separated from other portions of the building by construction having a fire-resistance rating of not less than two hours, and shall be equipped with an approved automatic sprinkler system.

CHAPTER C PUBLIC BUILDINGS, EXITS, ETC.

900.01 Obstruction of Exits.—No person shall at any time place an accumulation of any kind whatsoever before or upon any fire escape, emergency stairway or any other exit intended as a means of escape from fire.

900.02 School Fire Drills.—All schools in the City of Birmingham containing 50 or more children shall have fire drills at least once each year.

900.03 Fire Drills.—The fire alarm system and all alarm stations shall be tested each month.

school shall, in addition, maintain as a secondary fire alarm system in case of electrical failure, a manual hand alarm. Both alarm systems shall be used from time to time to acquaint each student of their significance.

900.03-1 All exits and exit facilities required by this ordinance or the Building Code of the City of Birmingham shall be maintained in proper condition.

900.03-2 All doors leading out of theatres, churches and other public buildings shall be equipped with panic hardware. This to include panic hardware on all doors leading from place of assembly, hall ways and street exit doors.

900.03-3 Public Assembly Room Capacity.—The capacity of any place of assembly in number of occupants, other than employees, shall be displayed at all times in a conspicuous place in the room or rooming.

900.03-4 The above total capacities shall be determined according to the following: (a) Assembly Rooms.—Fixed Seats—6 square feet of floor area per person. Non-Fixed Seats—10 square feet of floor area per person.

900.03-5 Where exit lights are required they shall be as follows: (1) Exit lights shall be of the type which are self-luminous or which are illuminated by an electric light of not less than twenty-watt capacity.

900.03-6 Nothing in this section shall prohibit the use of cut flowers or natural trees, plants, shrubs or grass for artistic enhancement of public buildings.

900.03-7 Where a gas hose connection is made, a listed gas valve shall be used.

900.03-8 Heating of Public Garages and High Hazard Use Group Buildings.—Heating of oil or gas fired furnaces may be permitted in public garages and High Hazard Use Group Buildings, as defined in the Building Code (BOCA).

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shall be provided for protection of rooms containing film.

900.09-9 Loose film and scraps shall be handled in accordance with the provisions of the Building Code of the City of Birmingham.

900.10 Boilers, Heaters, Ranges, Etc.—Boilers, heaters, ranges, etc., shall be installed and provided with safety devices, fire extinguishers, temperature controls, automatic shut-off, etc., as required by the Building Code of the City of Birmingham.

900.11 Seats and Aisles.—In buildings containing halls or auditoriums for 200 or more persons, seats shall be permanently fixed to the floor.

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CHAPTER 10 MISCELLANEOUS

1000.01 Fire Extinguishing Equipment.—All fire extinguishing equipment required by this ordinance or the Building Code of the City of Birmingham shall be of such type as is approved by the Bureau of Fire Prevention for the type of building.

1000.02 Chief of the Bureau of Fire Prevention shall survey each mercantile and manufacturing establishment, school, place of assembly, etc., and advise the owner of any fire extinguishing appliances which shall be provided.

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
