

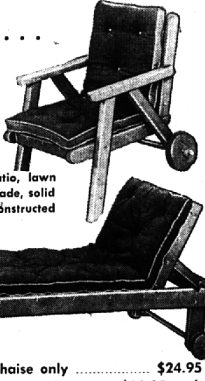
### A \$500 Winner

### Circuit Court Says No Gas Station At Lathrup Corner

LATHRUP — The Socony Mobil Oil Co., Inc., was denied Wednesday the right to build a gas station on the northeast corner of Sunnybrook and Southfield roads in Lathrup by Circuit Court Judge H. Russell Holland.

In the extensive opinion handed down by Judge Holland, he stated that a municipality near a large metropolitan area may constitutionally pass a one-use ordinance in order to retain its residential character.

JUDGE HOLLAND also held that the city had acted in good faith when they passed the zoning ordinance, although the company had petitioned for a building permit before the ordinance became effective (but after it had been introduced).

Judge Holland said that the ordinance was "not designed as a scheme to defeat the building permit."

# Few Protest State's Chrysler X-Way Route

Objections already had been made in months past. That's why last Thursday's public hearing on the state highway department's Walter P. Chrysler expressway through Oakland county passed with hardly a ripple.

## BITS OF BIRMINGHAM

### LARGEST RIPPLE at the hearing

was created by Richard A. Randall's protest against the expressway. A homeowner at 475 Kirk, Troy, Randall's group has fought the expressway route. Terminating it "an engineering monstrosity," the group even sued Troy over its municipal approval of the route.

### THE STATE has determined this route for the 21-mile stretch from 8 Mile road to the northeast corner of Pontiac.

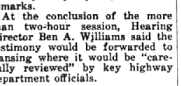

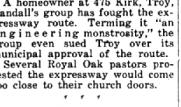
